THE TEN COMMANDMENTS

REQUIREMENTS TO ADVANCE TO UPPER LEVEL TRUMPET

- 1. Correct embouchure
 - a. Not playing on the red of the lip
 - b. Fairly centered (depending on lip/teeth structure)
 - c. Even pressure
- 2. Relaxed and consistent/constant air flow that is absent of tension
- 3. Lip bends and pedal tones
 - a. Bend down two half steps on all notes between F#³ and C⁵
 - b. Bend down one half step on all notes between C#⁵ and G⁵
 - c. Arpeggiate down to C³ and back up with a full tone
- 4. Tone is clear and even in all registers (F#3 to C6)
- 5. Articulation (and finger/tongue coordination) is unobtrusive and consistent with indicated styles
- 6. Major and all minor scales (natural, harmonic, and melodic) can be played at MM=86 according to the rhythmic pattern in *The Trumpet Player's Practice Compendium*.
- 7. Intonation is consistent through all registers
- 8. Dynamics are appropriately demonstrated from pp to ff
- 9. Successfully perform a Texas UIL Class 1 solo
- 10. Ability to sight-read advanced high school or college freshman level etudes
